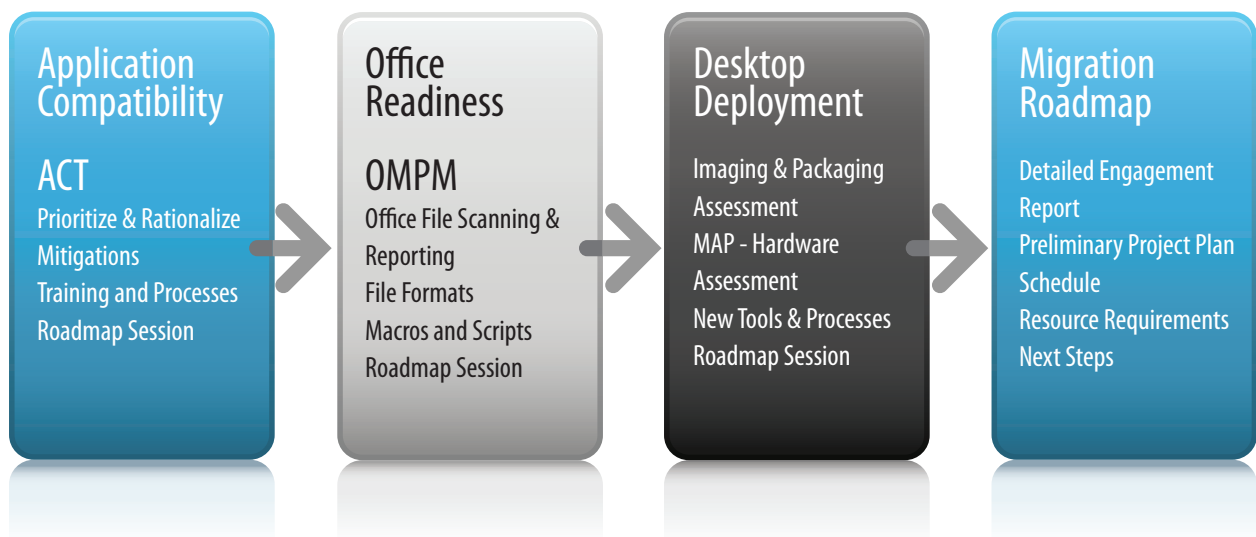

Office related macros and scripts that may not be compatible with the latest release are also reviewed.

Desktop Deployment
